Opening: The group was called to order at $6: 50 \mathrm{pm}$ and held a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer and the reading of the 12 Traditions and 12 Concepts of Service.

Introductions: Introduction of directors, officers, and visitors.
Announcement of Quorum: There were a total of 13 members present with 8 registered as voting.

Approval of Minutes: Reading and approval of the minutes from the March 18, 2013 Board of Directors meeting. Steve S made a motion to accept the March minutes as presented. Kate H seconded. Motion passed.

Chair's Report: Lorelei noted that she is keeping a calendar of annual duties of the Board and Officers, so that the next Chair's job will be easier.

Information Center Report: Kitty reviewed literature sales and donations from March 19 through May 17. Literature sales totaled $\$ 5,067.15$. Out-of-town sales were $\$ 2,483.81$. Donations totaled $\$ 1,703.53$. Walk-in sales were $\$ 352.35$. The sales grand total was
\$9,606.84. Literature purchases totaled \$1,812.28. Rosemary C asked if All-Texas sales were included in the March reports; Kitty responded that they were.

Treasurer's Report: Ann R did not have copies of the financial statements for this period and will send to the secretary for inclusion with the draft minutes. Ann R noted that the City of Austin had not sent a bill for utilities in 6 months, so that bill was rather expensive. Lorelei will give submitted tax forms to Kitty, and the forms will be available at the July 15 meeting. Rosemary C suggested adding tax form submission to the Chair's calendar.

Bylaws Review: Lorelei requested that copies of bylaws committee feedback be added to the minutes for the meeting and to an appendix in the Secretary's binder. The feedback will also be available online. The Secretary will ask the Webmaster to add a new link with the feedback to the bylaws page. The Board of Directors began reading the bylaws at 6.4.

- 6.4.4: Lorelei asked if we should add a column to the sign-in sheet to say, "share my information with the Board." Kitty said the Board had already agreed to share their information. Also, a copy of each sign-in sheet stays at the Information Center and is available to anyone who asks for it.
- 6.4.8: Allie asked if full name means first and last name. Yes-minutes sent electronically will include only first names with last initial; hard copy minutes kept in the Secretary's binder will include first and last names.
- 7.3: Jean B asked about the use of "executive session" instead of "candidates shall be asked to leave the room." Rosemary and Allie responded that everyday language is preferred to jargon. Bill would define executive or closed session as all visitors and officers leaving the room; Al-Anon has traditionally been more open. Bill noted that the only two circumstances when we have asked people to leave the room are elections and to discuss Kitty's compensation. Lorelei would like to create an index of terms.
- 6.6: Removal of Board member-because the Board was discussing asking members to leave the room, the question arose: should we add "shall be asked to leave the room" to 6.6 ? Bill responded that the Chair is not prohibited from declaring a closed session, so this addition is not necessary.
- 7.6: Jean asked to define "cause." Bill responded that the bylaws committee left it to the Board of Directors to define the cause because they didn't want to define a cause too narrowly. Jean asked to keep track of all decisions so that there are no arbitrary and capricious decisions.
- 7.8.4: Danielle noted a typo - a comma at the end of the sentence, rather than a period.
- 7.8.3: Lorelei asked about using electronic copies of bylaws. Bill read the bylaws committee's March response: "The bylaws committee recommends that clause 7.8 .3 be revised to read: 'The Secretary shall insure that members of the board have a copy of the current bylaws available to them'."
- The Board stopped at 7.9 and will begin at that point at the July meeting.

Lorelei asked Kitty to leave the room while the Board of Directors conducted an executive session.

## Standing Committees:

a. Meeting List: Steve-no actions to report. Steve has plans for the meeting list committee. Kitty will help Steve.
b. Finance: Do we need this committee? Bill said it is supposed to be a watchdog for the corporation's finances and would like to see it continue. Call for volunteers to be the chair of this committee.
c. Literature: Kitty handles all literature; no need for this committee. Allie mentioned that if something should happen to Kitty, we would need someone to know how to run the office. Kitty perhaps needs a computer helper because WSO sends everything electronically now. Kate will be the chair of the literature committee, and Lorelei will assist with typing.

b. Review Income Trends (Lorelei)

Business from the Floor: Allie mentioned that we need to audit the Information Center website and other websites that carry contact information for the Information Center. She received a note from someone who noticed that the Information Center website still had the Treadwell address on it.
